Why do we need an E-Safety policy?

- To keep us safe on the internet in and out of school
- To learn about appropriate websites and information
- So we know what to do if something strange occurs or that we are worried about



SMART rules

S - SAFE: Keep safe by being careful not to give out personal information to people.

M - MEETING: You should never meet up with someone you have met online. How do you know that they are who they say they are?

A - ACCEPTING: Don't accept messages or emails from people you don't know. If in doubt delete it and then find a grown up you trust and tell them.

R - RELIABLE: Information you find on the internet may not be true, or someone online may be lying about who they are.

T - TELL: Tell your parents/carers or a trusted grown up if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried online.

Child Friendly E-Safety Policy

We can use our child-friendly policy to remember the top tips for in school and at home too.



The internet is great because:

- You can learn lots of things
- You can have lots of fun
- It can help with our school work
- You can stay in touch with family & friends

Some online dangers include:

- Cyber bullying – nasty messages, swearing
- Stranger danger – Some people who we talk to online who we don't know are strangers
- Bad language – sometimes when we are online we can see or hear swear words that might upset us
- Content online – some material online is not suitable for children to look at
- Viruses – some emails can contain viruses



What our academy does to respond to E-Safety issues?

- We take online safety seriously
- We listen to the children involved and offer support
- We investigate and look at evidence
- We make sure children face up to the consequences of their actions
- We contact parents & carers



What does our academy provide to keep us safe?

- We maintain anti-virus software to keep viruses away
- We maintain internet filters to keep us from seeing inappropriate content
- The academy keeps access to I pads & Laptops secure
- The academy keeps our network and Wi-Fi secure
- All of the staff have training to keep children safe on the internet
- Searching on Google & other search engines is kept safe



If people are mean or worry me, what should I do?

- Tell a trusted adult straight away
- Stay calm and try not to get upset and angry
- Ignore the person
- Block and delete them
- Keep the messages for evidence

What should I not do?

- Do not keep worries to myself
- Do not be unkind or nasty back
- Do not get angry or upset
- Do not allow the person to keep being unkind
- Do not delete messages

Who can we tell if we have worries about e-safety or cyber bullying?

- Friends
- Family
