

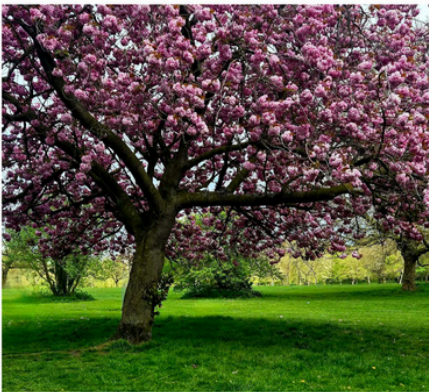

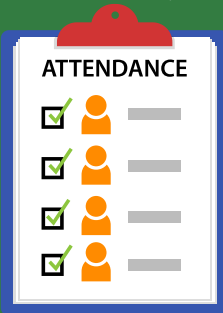
## David Attenborough turns 100!
